The Global Studies Internship Program enables Stanford students to extend knowledge beyond the classroom by engaging in immersive cultural and professional experiences around the world. The program also supports students for self-arranged internships. The overall stipend base is \$6,000 per student provided by the host organization and/or the program.

- Global Studies minors receive preference for the SGS internship program.
- Local language skills are based on the internship description requirements.
- Preferably, before beginning their internships, selected candidates should have taken at least one course regarding the internship region. The course can be taken in the spring quarter.
